Topic 3: Integrating and re-elaborating digital content	
Lesson Plan 5 – How to work with online software	
Duration: 45 minutes	
Aim	Students will learn how to use several software that are used to work online. They will learn how to upload their content there and how to share it with others.

Show them how to create an account in Google Drive, and how to access it from mobile devices or computers, using this link.</p> <p>1.2. Show the participants all the features that the program has. Dropbox</p> <p>2.1. Introduce the participants to Dropbox. Show the participants this Quick Start Guide to learn about Dropbox.</p>

4. Task 4. Final Project

4.1. Give students **see Handout 1.**

- 1) The instructions for the learners are to use a computer or smartphone to create:
 - a word document to present themselves
 - a PowerPoint presentation with some photos/infographics/video/audio about them and their hobbies, jobs, experiences in life, music preferences, etc.
 - an excel file with some relevant data about their lives (n. of marriages, n. of children, n. of degrees, n. of travels outside the country, etc.)
- 2) Set up a common online space to share the content they have created
- 3) Create groups and assign a person of the group. Tell them to choose one of the pieces, read it and try to guess who could be the author.

Task 1: Use a computer or smartphone to create:
