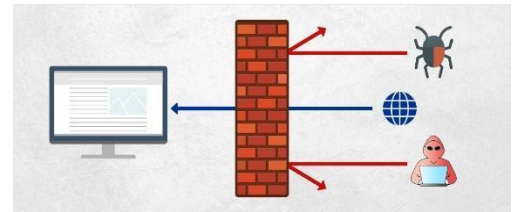

Topic 1 Title: Basic Internet Concepts/ Terms	
Lesson Plan 1 – What a Firewall is	
Duration: 60 minutes	
Aim	This lesson plan aims to clarify the concept of “firewall” and show its importance to keep equipment safe.
Target Group	Adults (seniors)
Facility/ Equipment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Classroom ● Internet access ● Projector ● Whiteboard
Tools/ Materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Sticky notes ● Handout 1 ● 1 Cardboard/ Paper A3 ● Markers ● <i>Bostik</i> glue pads or something to post on a wall or board in the classroom
Main Tasks	<p>1. Task 1: Introduction to the concept (8 mins)</p> <p>1.1 Present some definitions and explanation with Powerpoint (Teaching materials)</p> <p>2. Task 2: Show the video (2 mins)</p> <p>2.1 Start this task with a video https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=x1YLj06c3hM</p>



	<p>3. Task 3: Ask to write what a firewall is (45 mins)</p> <p>3.1 Provide your students with sticky-notes and ask them to write, with their own words, what they think a firewall is. (10 mins)</p> <p>3.2. Read out loudly all the answers, randomly, and discuss the results with the whole class. Find out a satisfactory definition in group (with a teacher's help to ensure that it is right). (25 mins)</p> <p>3.3 Ask a volunteer to write the group's description of "firewall" on the cardboard (<i>see Handout 1</i>) and fix it on a board or wall in your classroom. (10 mins)</p> <p>4. Task 4: Wrap up (5 mins)</p>
