			Duration: 90 minutes	
			Aim	This lesson plan aims to clarify what "applications" are, what they are for and how they facilitate everyday life.
Target Group	Adults (seniors)			
Facility/ Equipment	 Classroom Internet access Projector Computers/ Tablets/ Smartphones 			
Tools/ Materials	Handout 1 (x no. of students)Pens/pencils			
Main Tasks	 Task 1: Brainstorm/ discussion (15 mins) 1.1 Start some brainstorm activities with your students asking them the following questions: "Does anyone know what applications are?" "Do you think you've used them at any time?" "Can you identify any app?" Afterwards, say: "And if you look in your smartphone or computer/tablet, can you tell me some examples of apps?" Task 2: Introduction to the concept (10 mins) 			





2.1 Present the topic in PowerPoint (Teaching materials).

3. Task 3: Individual reflection exercise (45 mins)

3.1 Distribute handout 1 (see Handout 1) between your students and ask them to complete the questions on it.

4. Task 4: Share the results in a large group (15 mins)

4.1 Invite students to share freely what they did/wrote and how the process went.

5. Task 5: Wrap up (5 mins)
